## Costume Due Date

All items are due on **Monday, October 23rd**. This is necessary so costume fittings can be accomplished in the short time available.

## General costume information:

- Costume dept. has the option to reject items if they don't fit with the look of the play
- Leave tags on items, if not used they can be returned
- Please don't bring any item that can't be altered or changed
- Bring larger rather than smaller items so they can be more easily altered to fit
- Footwear should be well fitted and suited to all stage activity
- **Label each item with your child's name.**

# Hyenas

No shiny or neon fabrics

## Top

### Description:

Long sleeve, pull over, hooded, t-shirt. Color, grey

### Notes:

A sweat shirt might be too warm under the lights but you can bring one if you like.



## Bottom

### Description:

Cargo pants or jeans. Color, black or dark grey.

### Notes:

Pants can be a little worn and baggy but not so much that you can't dance in them. Bring a belt if you need one.



## Shoes

### Description:

Used/worn basketball, tennis, or board shoes, or motorcycle style boots. Color, dark grey or black

### Notes:

Worn looking is fine, so thrift stores could be a good place to find them.



## Gloves

### Description:

With or without fingers. Color, black

### Notes:

You can buy them with or without the fingers. If you bring gloves with fingers we will cut them off for you.
